NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

EXHIBITORS, THROUGH SUBMISSION OF ENTRY, ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THEY ARE KNOWLEDGEABLE OF THE CURRENT AAC RULES AND REGULATIONS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING...

This event will be held in accordance with the current rules and regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC). The obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications

All breeds and mixed breeds eighteen months of age and older (no exceptions) are eligible to compete. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs are ineligible, as are bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness, which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (judge's discretion).

As of January 1, 2001, all dogs must have an AAC number before their entries will be accepted in an AAC sanctioned trial. Dogs with numbers pending will not be eligible to compete. An application form for dog ID cards is available here: http://www.aac.ca/official_forms.htm

No leashes, collars, toys, food, or other training devices shall be allowed on the course or within 10 feet of the ring entrance. The only exception to this rule is leading your dog on leash to the start, then handing the leash to a ring steward.

All dogs must be **penned, crated, or leashed** when not in the ring. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds for entries if the dog or handler is *dismissed* from the competition for any reason.

LIMITED ENTRIES

(Approximately 30 dogs or 100 runs, depending on the classes offered)

- **Online** and **mailed** entries will be accepted. *Online entries are preferred.*
- Since this is a very limited trial, entries will be accepted until our manageable number of runs limit has been reached.
- If entries exceed the run limit, preference will be given to the entrant who's [here for a good time \(not a long time\)](#).
- Training Troop reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Anyone not in good standing with AAC or Training Troop will not be allowed entry.
- If entering online, entry fees & general agreement must be received before the start of the trial. You can elect to mail them prior to the trial or submit them at check-in.
- Cheques are to be made out to Training Troop and dated no later than the day of the trial.
- Cheques will be deposited, & must clear, before results are submitted to AAC.
- **Online entries will not be accepted for future trials if competitors cancel without notification.**
- Refunds will not be given for cancellations after the closing date *except* for bitches in season or injury to a dog, or handler, which physically prevents them from competing. **Refunds requested for any other reason will be handled on a case by case basis and will be at the discretion of Training Troop.**
- **There will be a \$25 charge on NSF cheques.**

NOTE: BY AAC RULES, ENTRIES ARE NOT VALID UNTIL PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES HAS BEEN RECEIVED OR CONFIRMED.

CLASS CHANGES

Class changes and/or withdrawals made after the closing date may not appear in the gate lists. Please make every effort to get your changes to the trial secretary ASAP.

HEIGHT CATEGORIES AND JUMP HEIGHTS

Your dog's height category is based upon its measured height as entered on its AAC height card. For Veteran class levels, all jumps must be set one or two jump heights lower than would be required in the regular classes; for Special class levels, all jumps shall be set one jump height lower than would be required in the regular classes. Anyone wishing to run "For Exhibition Only" will be charged the same as the regular competitors. By AAC rules, you will be ineligible for placings, qualifiers or prizes. This will not be reflected on your dog's permanent record.

RIBBONS & AWARDS

All classes will receive flat ribbons for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th placements and qualifying ribbons for qualifying rounds.

Title Rosettes are available for dog/handler teams who receive their AAC title on a qualifying round.

Training Troop ATChC plaques will be ordered for those dogs who earn their ATChC, SATChC or VATChC at a Training Troop trial.

Training Troop also recognizes the milestones of Bronze, Silver, Gold & Lifetime achievement awards.

AGILITY CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

FEO (For Exhibition or Experience Only)

Open to all dogs, 18 months of age or older, as described within the current AAC rules. The handler can choose to enter a dog FEO in any division, any class and/or any height but they will not be competing for placements or titles and the results will not be reflected on the dog's permanent record.

Regular Division

Open to all dogs, 18 months of age or older, as described within the current AAC rules.

Specials Division

Open to all dogs, 18 months of age or older, but intended for dogs which are of a size or stature that limits their jumping ability.

Veteran Division

For dogs seven years of age or older that are currently competing in the Regular Division and for dogs five years of age or older which have competed in the Specials Division for a minimum of one calendar year.

Standard Classes

Standard agility classes demonstrate the dog's ability to perform the minimum equipment & handling requirements of the various performance levels (starters, advanced, masters).

Games Classes

Snooker demonstrates the handler & dog's versatility as they work together against the clock. The object of the game is to accumulate as many points as possible in the opening and closing sequences within the allotted time.

Gamblers demonstrates the handler's strategy and the dog's ability to work at a distance from the handler. The object of this game is to accumulate as many points as possible during the opening sequence and successfully complete the gamble.

Jumpers demonstrates a dog's natural jumping ability. The dog is required to complete a course comprised of hurdles and tunnels as prescribed by the judge.

Team Relay consists of 2 dogs, each with a different handler. The game demonstrates team spirit, strategy and sportsmanship.

Steeplechase demonstrates the dog's ability to run and jump at speeds while maintaining control on the A-frame and weave poles.

Masters Challenge tests the handling skills and speed of the dog/handler teams by challenging them at a level reflecting the similarity to Worlds level courses in their difficulty and handling requirements.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, the holding of the even and/or the opportunity to have this dog participate or be judged, I/We agree as follows: (I) while at or in proximity to this event, to freely assume all risk of loss (including death) or damage or injury, collectively called "Loss", to myself, this dog or any dog under my control, and to members of my family and my guests, and to our property; (II) to release and discharge and to hold harmless and indemnify the organizing committee, the club and its directors, officers and members, the sanctioning body for the event (if any), sponsors of the event (if any), and the owners of the premises grounds upon which the event is held and their respective employees and agents, collectively called the "Releasees", of and from any and all claims, and from all liability of any nature, for all Loss which I or this dog or any dog under my control or members of my family or my guests or our property may suffer for any reason or cause whatsoever, including specifically, but without limitation, all Loss resulting from the action or inaction of any dog, including this dog, or its owner or handler, or by the Releasees, or any of them whether through negligence or otherwise. I/We expressly assume the risk and liability for all such Loss while attending or proximity to this event and waive any and all claims relating thereto; (III) to hold harmless and indemnify the Releasees, and each of the of and from any and all claims by third parties, and from all liability of any nature, for all Loss, in relation to claims against me or through me, or against or through any member of my family or any other person accompanying me or attending as my guest or in my place, or arising as a result of any action or inaction by me or by this dog, or its owner or handler, or by any member of my family or any other person accompanying me or attending as my guest or in my place, or by the Releasees or any of the in relation thereto, whether through negligence or otherwise. I/We expressly assume that all responsibility and liability for all such claims; and (IV) that all indemnities herein shall be by full and complete indemnities, including legal costs on a solicitor and client basis.

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the dog entered hereon. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) have read, understand and will abide by the Official Rules and Regulations of the Agility Association of Canada, Inc. in effect at the time of this entry, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the Agility Trial Schedule for this event. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and General Agreement/Disclaimer. I (we) agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with such Official Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to

abide by any decisions made in accordance with them.

I/We understand that the entry is accepted on the condition that I am/we are willing to volunteer.
